

Dear Johan,

ISEP wants to host the CDIO Worldwide Fall Meeting 2015 in October-November 2015.

1. Why are you interested in hosting a CDIO Fall meeting or International conference?

ISEP: We are interested in hosting a CDIO Fall meeting because we have adopted CDIO in large scale and we would like to increase the visibility and adoption of CDIO worldwide, but specially in portuguese-speaking and/or CPLP countries (Brazil, Angola, Mozambique, etc), as well as southern Europe and northern Africa.

2. Please tell us why your school and city would make a good place to hold a CDIO meeting/conference. (e.g., is there good quality accommodation near to the conference venue/campus?)

ISEP: Porto was/is Best European holiday destination in 2013 and 2014, with lots of good hostels, hotels, bed & breakfasts, etc. There are several hotels near ISEP, but nice hostels/hotels in city center have a direct metro line taking less than 12 minutes to travel to/from center to ISEP. The Porto metro is one of the most moderns in Europe, with a direct line from/to airport to city center (30 minutes).

3. What facilities do you have on campus for the meeting? Do you have space for both plenary and breakout sessions? Can meeting attendees have wireless access? Do you have computer projection? Other?

ISEP: Yes. We have a Congress Center capable of hosting events with up to 440 attendants in a single large auditorium, but ISEP has also smaller auditoriums (200, 100, 70, 50), as well as conference rooms, amphitheaters, exhibition hall, etc. ISEP has wifi support (Eduroam and local networks) and computers for public use may be provided.

ISEP: In 2007 and 2011 we hosted meetings related to CDIO and HEI. ISEP also has lots of experience in organizing and hosting international events, some of them not even related with engineering and education.

6. Do you have support staff who can help with meeting organization (e.g., handling registrations, staffing the welcome desk, etc.)

ISEP: we have a Congress Center department that execute tasks like handling registrations, managing the welcome desk, preparing rooms and equipments, supporting sessions, etc. ISEP also has several large and medium size restaurants/canteens inside the campus, but a big tent for a large number of people+meals has been used before and is a possible option.

7. How do international participants most effectively travel to your campus?

ISEP: Porto has an international airport with international plus low cost airline companies: Ryanair, EasyJet, Transavia, etc. Porto Airport (IATA code: OPO) is about 11 km from the city center, in one of the country's most important industrial and trading areas. Nowadays, 15 airlines are operating regularly at our airport with flights to more than 65 destinations. With an annual traffic of more than 6 million passengers, Porto airport was distinguished as the 3rd Best European Airport in 2013 by ACI (Airport Council International).
